

**Location:

From the east:

- From the NYS Thruway Exit 45 (Victor) take I-490 West through Rochester and west to Exit 8 for Route 531.
- Take 531 to the end, turn right at Washington Street, then turn left on Route 31 West. Follow signs to Brockport (6 miles). Go past Wegman's, turn right on Commencement Drive.

From the south:

- From I-390 North, take I-490 West
- Follow directions from the east above
- Exit 8 is one mile west of I-390

From the west:

- From NYS Thruway Exit 47 (Leroy) take Route 19 North to Brockport (about 13 miles). Turn left onto Route 31 West. Follow signs to The College at Brockport.
- To enter the campus, turn right on Commencement Drive.

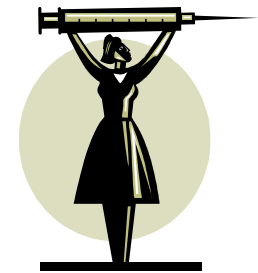
